Effective Jan 30st, 2017 TB skin testing for the purposes of **education** is insured under the Ontario Health Insurance Plan. **However, as our clinic is not funded under OHIP; we will be continuing to charge for providing TB Skin Testing for students** (as we are not using publicly funded Tubersol/TB Skin Test Serum).

As per our website and booking portal all students are encouraged to contact their primary care provider (family doctor, nurse practitioner or clinic) to determine if they are able to accommodate them for TB skin tests. Some providers will provide the test free of charge, but still charge for completion of forms and documentation.

TB Skin Tests are not covered under OHIP for the purposes of employment or placement in a seniors residential home/facility.
